|  | Team squadding will be done by a <br> random draw. The two members of <br> each team must be squadded to fire <br> next to each other on the same squad, <br> with the man firing first and the <br> woman second. Teams from the same <br> nation shall not be in the same squad. |

| Final: | After the end of Qualification, the <br> ranking of the teams will be decided by <br> the combined results of the 2 members <br> of each team (1man \& woman) <br> $75 \times 2=150$ as per ISSF rule 9.14.5.2. <br> $\& 9.15 .3$ (Team Ties). <br> The top four (4) teams will qualify to <br> compete in the Final (Medal Matches). <br> Teams in places 1 and 2 will qualify for <br> the Gold/Silver Medal Match, teams in <br> places and 4 will qualify for the <br> Bronze Medal Match. The remainder of <br> the teams (5 place and below) will be <br> ranked according to their results as <br> per ISSF rule $9.14 .5 .2 . \& 9.15 .3$ (Team <br> Ties). <br> If two or more teams are tied for any <br> position from 1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ to 4 $4^{\text {th }}$ place, their <br> places must be decided by a shoot-off <br> as per section 11 below. <br> In case of more than one shoot-off, |
| lower position shoot-offs must be shot |  |
| first, followed by higher position shoot |  |
| offs. |  |


| 9. Allocation of new BIB numbers after Qualification and any eventual shoot-offs: | After Qualification and any eventual shoot-offs, the 4 teams which will qualify for the Final (Medal Matches Gold/Silver \& Bronze) will be allocated new BIB numbers on the basis of their ranking. The athletes of the team in place 1 will both receive BIB numbers 1 and 1 . The athletes of the team in place 2 will both receive BIB numbers 2 and 2, 3 and 3, 4 and 4. The BIB numbers must also bear the abbreviation of the nation of each team. <br> Example: |
