

ISSF WORLD RANKING SYSTEM 2022-2024 years (in force as of January 1st 2022)

1. The World Ranking:

- a) The World Ranking determines the ranking of the athletes according to their achievements in the ISSF Championships during a calendar year starting from January 1st 2022 year;
- b) The World Ranking events are:

Rifle	Pistol	Shotgun
10m Air Rifle Men	10m Air Pistol Men	Trap Men
50m Rifle 3 Positions Men	25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men	Skeet Men
10m Air Rifle Women	10m Air Pistol Women	Trap Women
50m Rifle 3 Positions Women	25m Pistol Women	Skeet Women

- c) The World Ranking is valid for:

- the qualification for the Final Tournament of Year (e.g. President's Trophy);
- the selection of candidates for the Golden Target;
- award for the best athletes of the season;

- d) The World Ranking starts from zero on January 1st of each calendar year.

Note:

The maximum number of the ISSF Championships that will count for the 2022 World Ranking is four (4). Athletes can compete in all events during the year but only the four (4) best results with the most points for each athlete in each event will count to the World Ranking.

2. The Qualification Ranking for the Olympic Games (QROG)

- a) The QROG determines the ranking of the athletes according to their achievements in the ISSF Qualifying competitions for the Olympic Games during the whole Olympic Qualification period in the shooting sport approved by the IOC;

- b) The QROG events are:

- individual events included in the program of the respective Olympic Games;

- c) The QROG is valid for:

- receiving direct Quota Place/Places to the Olympic Games in accordance with the Qualification system approved by the IOC Executive Committee;
- eligibility for the Invitation Places allocated by the Tripartite Commission;
- eligibility for the not used Quota Places reallocated according to the Qualification system approved by the IOC Executive Committee;

- d) The points earned at a Qualifying competition are valid through the whole Olympic Qualification period approved by the IOC;

- e) Only athletes who obtained points within the respective QROG are eligible to take part in the Olympic Games.

Note:

The maximum number of the ISSF Championships that will count for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games Qualification Ranking is ten (10). Athletes can compete in all Qualifying competitions during the Olympic Qualification period but only the 10 (ten) best results with the most points for each athlete in each event will count to the QROG.

3. ISSF Championships where the Ranking points can be earned:

a) World Ranking:

- Olympic Games;
- World Championships;
- World Cups;
- Grand Prix (if scheduled before the final tournament of the year);
- Continental Championships/Continental Games (if scheduled before the Final Tournament of the Year)

b) Qualification Ranking for the Olympic Games:

- World Championships;
- World Cups;
- Grand Prix;
- Continental Championships/Continental Games

4. Points system:

- Based on the level of the ISSF Championship;
- Reflects the achieved result;
- Depends on the number of participants

Notes:

1. The ISSF General Regulations (Article 7.5.4.) establish that in the ISSF Championships, other than World Championships and World Championships Juniors, each nation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) athletes can only compete for the ranking points. The Coach/Team leader prior to the competition start must indicate these three (3) athletes.
2. In case one of these "other two (2) athletes" or both of them are positioned after Qualification among the qualified athletes for the final, than this (these) athlete(s) will be ranked immediately after the finalists and will receive the points from the first place out of the final (Eg. In case of 8 finalists the athlete(s) pushed out of the final according to Article 7.5.4 ISSF General Regulations will be ranked and will receive the points for the 9th place).The available place(s) in the Final should be allocated to the next top ranked athlete(s) according to the Qualification ranking among those indicated eligible in accordance with Article 7.5.4 ISSF General Regulations by coach/team leader prior to start of competition.
3. If one or more athlete(s) eligible for the final have the same result than the last qualified athlete for the final, then they will receive the same amount of ranking points for the first place out of the final. For example, in case of 8 finalists, the athlete(s) that have the same score as the 8th placed athlete and do not proceed into the final will receive the points for the 9th place. This distribution also applies in case a shoot-off is required by the rules to decide the athlete(s) that will qualify for the final. The position will be distributed based on the result of the shoot-off. All athlete(s) not qualified to participate in the final after the shoot-off will receive the same amount of ranking points of the first position out of the final. For example, in case of 8 finalists the athlete(s) that loose the shoot-off and don't get in the final will receive the points for the 9th place.
